Washington, D.C. – The first deadline for the 2011 *Politics on Film* festival is quickly approaching. Filmmakers wishing to take advantage of the “early bird” submission window must submit their films by **December 15, 2010**.

Submissions for the festival, which will take place May 3-8 in Washington, D.C., will continue to be accepted until the final deadline of **February 28, 2011** (postmarked). Films can be submitted to one of three categories: Feature (domestic), Documentary (domestic) and International.
